Dear Parents / Carers,

A big thank you to everyone who came along to support our 'Sprummer Fayre' on Saturday. We could not have asked for a better day! It was great to see so many people from our school community and the local community spending time together and enjoying the sunshine. I would like to thank the Parent Council, parent helpers and staff for their hard work in making the fayre such a great success. We raised £2055 which will go towards the play equipment for our playground. Well done everyone!

This term many our classes will be going on visits linked to their Social Studies topics. On Tuesday of this week Primary 6 will be visiting Deans Community High School as they begin their transition programme. This week classes from Primary 1 - Primary 6 will be visiting the new Nu Moves studio in Deans to take part in dance sessions. And later this month we will also welcome our new Primary 1 pupils into school for their afternoon visits.

As part of our in-service day last week all our staff were working alongside Mike Harvey from Lowport Outdoor Centre on outdoor learning activities. We hope that all classes will benefit from spending more time outside in our playground and in the local area.

LITERACY

In the upper school several new approaches have been introduced to develop our pupils' literacy skills. Pupils in Primary 4-7 have been writing every day this term. Sometimes we only write for 10 minutes but these extra opportunities to practise key skills or to develop self-expression have led to significant improvements in the standard of writing in class and a much more positive attitude to settling to written tasks. Pupils have been engaging in peer assessment of daily writing, learning to give appropriate feedback to each other, which is increasing the sense of ownership towards their writing tasks. Since the Easter holidays Primary 7 have been learning a new script and this has led to almost all children feeling more positive about their handwriting and having a beautiful mature style to take with them to High School. Primary 5 are now experimenting with the use guided meditation to express themselves in their writing, improving their use of adjectives and descriptive phrases, as well as their sense of wellbeing.

In modern languages, Primary 5 have been improving their Spanish vocabulary with the daily use of simple vocabulary such as days of the week, months, body parts, numbers, greetings and classroom instructions. These skills will be put to the test with some volunteers leading small group Spanish activities for P7.

COMMUNICATION WITH SCHOOL
